

CKY IB Diploma May 2015 Preliminary Results

Po Leung Kuk CKY School is delighted to announce the 2015 IB Diploma results attained by our cohort of 72 students in Year 12. One candidate achieved the full mark of 45 points, and 23.61% of our candidates the excellent score of 40 points or above. 70 candidates received the IB Diploma, including 65 Bilingual Diploma recipients. The general overview of our students' achievement as published by IBO on 6th July 2015 is as follows:
